



# HOW TO INSTALL RVLogin

Thank you for choosing RVLogin. In this guide we will guide you through individual steps taken for installing RVLogin after you get it from RVGlobalSoft.com.

If you do not yet get the free license of RVLogin, please go to [RVGlobalSoft.com/Rvlogin](http://RVGlobalSoft.com/Rvlogin) first.

If you have problem with the installation, please ask our NEW support system from [HERE](#).

1. After ordering RVLogin free license from RVGlobalSoft.com, install RVLogin via SSH (as root) by running the following command.


```
cd /usr/src; rm -f rvlogininstall.sh; wget http://download.rvglobalsoft.com/rvlogininstall.sh; chmod +x rvlogininstall.sh; ./rvlogininstall.sh
```

## 2. You will see a successful page like this:

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
3. Go to your **WHM > Plugins > RVGlobalSoft Manager**. And configure RVLogin by clicking on **RVLogin Manager** icon.

You can create a URL for RVLogin Access as a Single sign-on server, such as yourdomainname.com. This will help you easy access to your Single sign-on server in one domain name browsing on URL tab as a website, instead of going to **WHM > Plugins > RVGlobalsoft Manager > RVLogin Manager**.

4. Create a URL for the single sign-on by going to **WHM > Plugins > RVGlobalsoft Manager > RVLogin Manager**. Then, click on **"WHM Single sign on"** tab.

Here you can create a URL for RVLogin Access as a Single sign-on server, such as yourdomainname.com. This will help you easy access to your Single sign-on server.

### RVLogin for WHM Single Sign-on

Create a Single Sign-on page for all WHMs and secure your access of individual users by RV2Factor. Without RV2Factor, you can still use RVLogin to do a single sign-on to all of your WHMs, but it is not recommended.



**Access RVLogin URL**

1. Launch your company login URL and get to RVLogin Gateway Page
2. Type in "root" in the user field.
3. Type your root password in the password field.

**If your RV2Factor is activated,...**

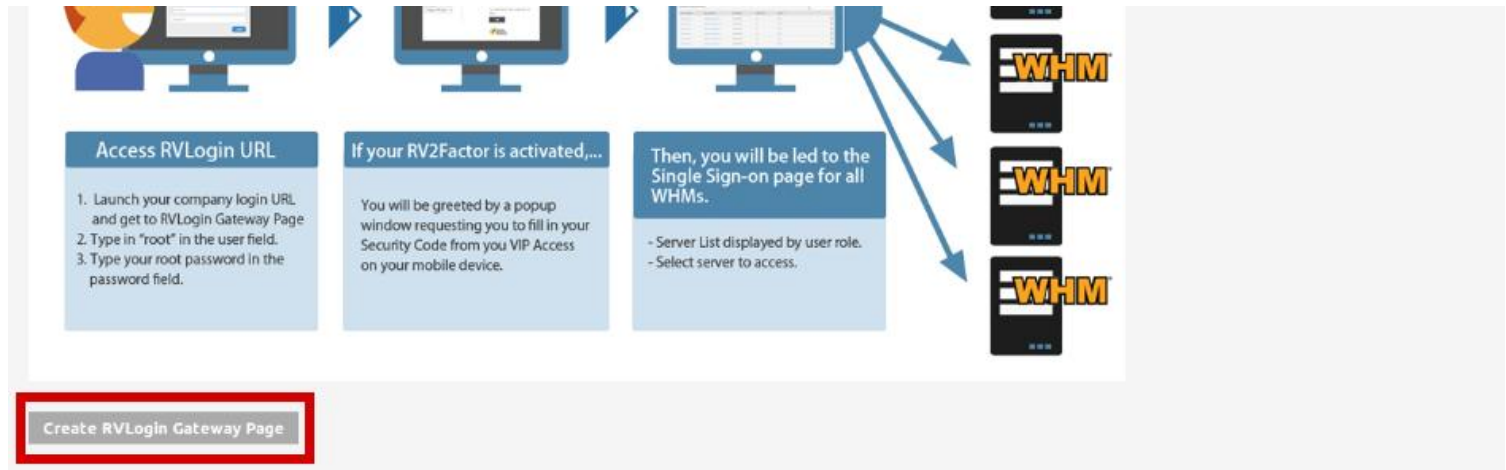
You will be greeted by a popup window requesting you to fill in your Security Code from your mobile device.

**Then, you will be led to the Single Sign-on page for all WHMs.**

- Select server to access.



5. Click "Create RVLogin Gateway Page" button to get past the intro page, and continue.





6. On page "Your RVLogin Gateway URL", insert your domain in RVLogin gateway URL field. And do the settings in the guide under the field.



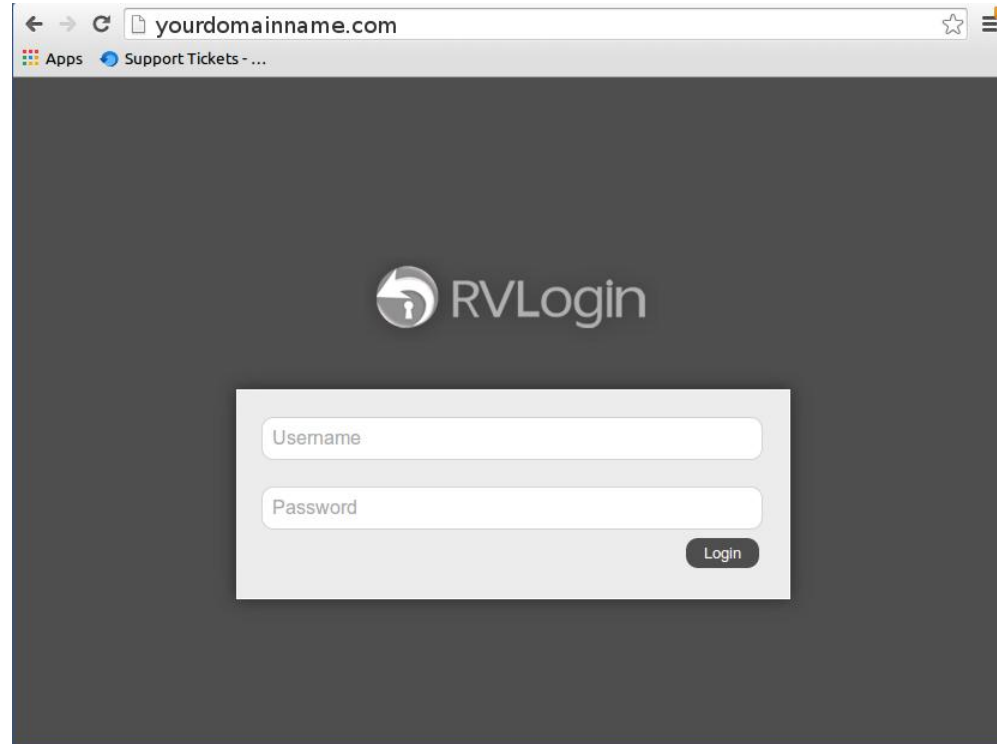
1. Click the Implement file here. Download
